Dear Bill:

Please accept the following as a report of the Public Works Department activities for the above referenced period.

**Winter Preparation:**

- Welding
- Tires
- New Spreader rack fabrications
- Paint arrows to catch basins
- Plow markers install town-wide
- 3 sanders mounted 10-15-2018
- Resolve sander auger problems
- Resolve sander spinner problems
- Resolve sander lighting problems
- Remove mower on the trackless machine and install snow blower and sidewalk sander.
- Grind rust off of all truck frames and then primer paint followed by applying rubberized undercoating.
- Install/replace as needed the carbide cutting edges on plows.
- Paint all front plows after rust removal and primer application.
- Paint all wing plows after rust removal and primer application.
- Paint all wing towers after rust removal and primer application.
- Paint all plow frames after rust removal and primer application.
- Shorten sander chains stretched last winter.
- Replace truck sideboards as needed.
- November 15<sup>th</sup> all trucks ready for winter.
- Order salt and sand replacement as needed.

**Winter Prep and Miscellaneous:**

- Beach entrances bermed off.
- Beach winter fence installed. ( pulled down by Army Corp. of engineers)
- Double-boiled linseed oil applied to concrete sidewalks.
- Installed winter snow fence Gove Road stop drifts from the park.

**Miscellaneous drainage problems addressed:**

- Four problems on Belgian Way
- One problem on Dow's Lane
- One problem on Farm Lane.

**Special Items:**

- Riverside and Pickering Marine Engineering contacted for repairs this spring or summer to the Town's pier and float. Wetland permits will be needed.
- Beach rake sent to Waterbury, Ct. for repairs to ensure it is 100% working next summer.
- Atlantic Recycling Equipment, Rollinsford, NH was contacted to address garbage compactor issues. This work is scheduled for January and will most likely result in the garbage not being compacted for three consecutive days.
- Automotive diagnostic vehicle computer reported to our Police Department as possibly stolen, certainly missing?

**Parks, Cemeteries, and Rubbish:**

- Mowing football field.
- Last mowing and trimming in cemeteries.
- Marking/Mark out Governor Weare and Vets Park football lines.
- Funeral preparation.
- Pick up and store after washing miscellaneous barrels town-wide.
- Pump out Leachate as needed.
- Cut and remove brush in cemeteries.
- Fill potholes.
- October 19<sup>th</sup> Household Hazardous Waste day in Exeter.
- Town Hall Christmas Tree
- Prep bathrooms for winter, drainpipes and add antifreeze in traps.
- Shut off outside water Parks and Cemeteries.

**Education and training:**

- December 4, 2019 – NH Coastal Climate- Climate Adaption
