

Hello Bill:

I hope this message finds you and Kelly well. I am preparing two NHDES Dredge and Fill applications for Keith Sicard, copied herein, and owner of two parcels located at 37 and 38 Cross Beach Road in Seabrook. As you know, the Town of Seabrook owns the land the salt marsh is located on which is directly abuts the two subject lots. The two lots have associated with them proposals for improvement to the environmental components including removal of structures from the upland edge of the previously-developed upland Tidal Buffer Zone (TBZ), a decrease in impervious surface area, flood vented foundations to improve storm attenuation, and TBZ enhancement plantings.

As you know, abutter concurrence for impacts to the jurisdictional TBZ within 10-feet of a shared property boundary is part and parcel of the NHDES permitting process. We are hoping that you will sign, and have Kelly witness the two attached abutter concurrence forms and return PDFs to me at your earliest convenience.
