CHANGE IN REC POLICY

Effective Monday, March 25th, 2024

The Seabrook Recreation Department will be changing our Open Areas Policy to the following. Please take notice.

- In order to be eligible for Open Areas, youth will need to be 4th Grade and above. Youth 3rd grade and below will no longer have Open Areas. Please make sure to make other arrangements for youth 3rd Grade and below. **Check out our After-school Program Offerings!**
- 4th-5th Grade will no longer be allowed to exit the building unless there is direct staff supervision. This includes utilizing outdoor areas and walking off of the Recreation Department premises. The Seabrook Recreation Department will provide outdoor supervision when we are able to do so. **There is still our Game Room, Lobby and Gym available!**
**Students who arrive by their own means of transportation ie; Skateboard, bicycle, etc. will be allowed to leave the premises before dark.*
- 6th Grade and above will still be allowed to exit the building. Ie; Irving, Starbucks, etc.
