On Tuesday, May 7, 2024 an inspection was conducted in conjunction with Seabrook Code Enforcement Lacey Fowler at a permanent structure at 287 Lafayette Rd., known as Atomic Fireworks Inc. The inspection found no violations with Seabrook Town Code 162-3, State Fire Code Saf-C 6000, NFPA 1, NFPA 101 and NFPA 1124. The fire suppression system, fire alarm and fire extinguishers are current with inspections. Housekeeping is in order, no debris found inside or outside and all means of egress are clear. This fire inspector finds Atomic Fireworks Inc. to be compliant and recommends renewal of annual license to sell permissible fireworks.

The structure is permanent and equipped with the required sprinkler system.


- Proof that the building in which the business shall be located conforms to all applicable building codes, zoning codes and local ordinances.

Change of Address (27 CFR 555.54(a)(1)). Licensees or permittees may during the term of their current license or permit remove their business or operations to a new location at which they intend regularly to carry on such business or operations. The licensee or permittee is required to give notification of the new location of the business or operations not less than 10 days prior to such removal with the Chief, Federal Explosives Licensing Center. The license or permit will be valid for the remainder of the term of the original license or permit. (The Chief, FELC, shall, if the licensee or permittee is not qualified, refer the request for amended license or permit to the Director of Industry Operations for denial in accordance with § 555.54.)

Right of Succession (27 CFR 555.59). (a) Certain persons other than the licensee or permittee may secure the right to carry on the same explosive materials business or operations at the same address shown on, and for the remainder of the term of, a current license or permit. Such persons are: (1) The surviving spouse or child, or executor, administrator, or other legal representative of a deceased licensee or permittee; and (2) A receiver or trustee in bankruptcy, or an assignee for benefit of creditors. (b) In order to secure the right provided by this section, the person or persons continuing the business or operations shall furnish the license or permit for that business or operations for endorsement of such succession to the Chief, FELC, within 30 days from the date on which the successor begins to carry on the business or operations.

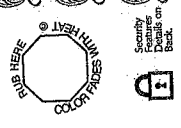
