We were able to complete the Styrker Ambulance Equipment deal we began in the last quarter of 2023. We will begin to receive the equipment over the coming months and getting our ambulances fitted for the new equipment.

We've had multiple members go to different learning events like the FDIC Conference, Dispatchers conference, Canine training which will be introduced dept wide in the coming months. We also had members go to Concord, NH for our internship program with Winnacunnet HS and their ELO program. The Fire Academy hosted a presentation on the internship program in an attempt to get highschoolers more interested in getting into the fire and EMS profession.

Our new Engine will have an inspection at the factory in Louisiana in July.
