

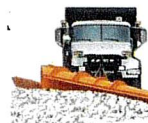
Dear Bill,

Please accept the following as a report of the Public Works activities, accomplishments, challenges, and problems during the above referenced time frame.

1. Almost completed Warrant Article #9 - Town wide paving.
2. Completed Warrant Article #10 - Replaced rubbish truck.
3. Completed Warrant Article # 16 – Replaced J.D. Tractor.
4. Prior to Memorial Day: Installed American flags on Rte 1A  
Memorial Day: All Cemeteries and War Memorials in an acceptable condition for a proper Memorial Day observance.  
Memorial Day weekend: Opened a clean Welcome Center.
5. Prior to Memorial Day: changed the traffic pattern on beach streets.
6. Completed the permitted section of Andover Street boardwalk.
7. Prior to Memorial Day: removed winter fences from North beach in Seabrook.
8. Prior to Memorial Day: bulldozed the North beach.
9. Prior to Memorial Day: removed all sand berms from beach entrances having same.
10. Prior to Memorial Day: raked the North beach.
11. Prior to Memorial Day: repainted stop bars on beach streets.
12. On June 9<sup>th</sup> Sunday received notification from N.H. Fish and Game department – No raking allowed anywhere on Seabrook beach = Plover chicks
13. Emergency repairs to Quaker Lane catch basins collapsed.
14. Hauled away excess bark mulch around town trees and refreshed bark mulch areas where no trees are being impacted.
15. Hang, Wash, and Lubricate spreaders. Painting plows
16. Begin catch basin vacuum cleaning.
17. Repaired broken water lines – Wildwood Cemetery
18. Remove sand Tilton Street boardwalk
19. Mow and trim 18 War memorials, 3 State Islands.
20. Put out and took down small parade flags on parade route and front of large cemeteries.
21. Transfer Station opened and manned 5.5 days a week.
22. Mon-Fri: Trash pickup curbside.
23. Mon-Fri: Recycle pickup curbside.
