Please accept the following as a report of the Public Works activities, accomplishments, challenges and problems during the above referenced time frame.


- October 4<sup>th</sup> 2024      Ralph Welch, Rubbish Foreman with CDL arrested

Arrested by N.H. State Police 3 charged with a Felony and 2 charged with Misdemeanors.

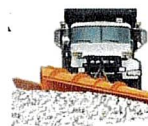
