Thank you for contacting the National Personnel Records Center. The record needed to answer your inquiry is not in our files. If the record was here on July 12, 1973, it would have been in the area that suffered the most damage in the fire on that date and may have been destroyed. The fire destroyed the major portion of records of Army military personnel for the period 1912 through 1959, and records of Air Force personnel with surnames Hubbard through Z for the period 1947 through 1963. Fortunately, there are other records sources that often contain information which can be used to reconstruct service record data lost in the fire; however, complete records cannot be reconstructed.

We have been attempting to verify the veteran's military service from the information that has been provided. We have conducted extensive searches of every records source and alternate records source at this Center; however, we have been unable to locate any information that would help us verify the veteran's military service. We also checked with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), which is a reliable source of information, but this agency was not able to furnish any data indicating that the veteran served in the U.S. Armed Forces.

For a further search, please furnish us with any papers you may have which may provide additional information about the requested military service, such as military orders, awards, citations and/or military addresses shown on letters mailed home. Unfortunately, without any new data, we will not be able to conduct a further search. We regret that we are unable to provide a more positive response.

You may wish to check with any employers, schools, or veterans' organizations to whom you may have provided a copy of your separation document (DD 214).


