MAINTENANCE

Maintenance of the building has been going well. We continue to work as a team to make sure that the sanitizing and daily cleaning is complete and safe for employees and patrons utilizing the facility. Our full time custodial maintenance has left the rec. center and we have been utilizing DPW employees to try to make sure the position is covered. Interviews have begun for the position that is open and we hope to fulfill the position no later than Friday, January 31st, 2025.

We continue to maintain the HVAC system within the building. We have had to have some repairs completed.

We have an incredible night employee who makes sure the building is ready to open the next day. A lot of hard work goes on after 9pm when we are closed.

The lighting project has come to a close creating a brighter more efficient lighting source for the Recreation Department. Training on the lighting system is to be completed sometime this week 1/26-1/31.

Our camera system has been upgraded and installed. We are just waiting on monitors to be installed to be able to view the cameras easier.

We have replaced the blower motor for the gym and the heat exchanger unit in the game room. One of our modine heaters will be replaced as well.

We are happy to announce that our kitchen project is near complete. The kitchen will be painted, appliances installed and we are hoping to announce a date for a grand viewing with complimentary snacks & waters.
