
RE: **DPW Monthly Report – June 12, 2025 – October 3, 2025**

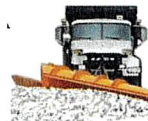
Dear Bill,

Please accept the following as a report of the Public Works activities, accomplishments, challenges and problems during the above referenced time frame.

- Cemetery – Parks Foreman Forrest Carter has returned to work during this time frame
- Solid Waste “Rubbish & Recycling” Foreman Ralph Welch has returned to work during this time frame
- Heavy Equipment Operator Herb Randall has returned to work during this time frame
- State of N.H. Fish & Game Department finally gave us the green light to rake the beach in August
- Welcome Center “Public Toilets” opened for the summer & closed after the Seafood Festival on September 7th
- Traffic pattern on beach streets changed after 4th of July
- Mosquito Contractor has retrieved the Green Head boxes, and they will be stored at the Transfer Station for the winter
- Transfer Station Scale House has a new roof. Thank you, Curtis Slayton, and crew.
- Transfer Station 27-year-old Baler repaired after breaking down late this summer
- DAM Maintenance worked on in September
- Athletic fields mowed, prepped and lined almost daily
- Cemeteries, War Memorials, mowed and trimmed
- TEC & AECOM have filed EPA Reports on Stormwater on time
- State Inspection on Trucks done in September
- Prepping trucks and sanders for winter has started
